Dr. Tillery is a second-generation Oral Surgeon and a Florida native, born in Miami, Florida where his father began his Oral Surgery practice before moving his family and practice to Winter Park in 1960. Dr Tillery, Jr attended and graduated from Winter Park High School. He earned his Bachelor of Science degree at Auburn University before attending the University of Florida where he earned his DMD degree. He then attended the University of Texas where he completed a 12-month residency in Anesthesiology before completing his Residency in Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery at Parkland Memorial Hospital in Dallas in 1988. Upon completing his Residency, he returned to Winter Park and joined a single specialty group practice where his primary emphasis was hospital based surgery--Orthognathic, Facial Reconstruction and Temporomandibular Joint surgery, performing thousands of such procedures.

In 1997, he left his group practice to pursue his interest in the surgical placement of Dental Implants and associated bone grafting procedures to facilitate Dental Implant placement to rehabilitate patients who had lost their teeth, portions of their jaws and their associated chewing function. Working in conjunction with other dental specialists in the Central Florida area, using a team approach, Dr. Tillery and his dental colleagues cooperate to allow each team member to focus on their area of expertise to provide consistent optimal outcomes.

To that end, his interests in performing complicated surgical implant procedures to allow dental reconstruction for demanding patients with terminal stage dentition using immediate fixed prosthetic solutions has grown. He has participated in tens of thousands of these reconstructive cases using conventional and zygomatic implants.

His professional interests include the use of CT guided dental implant surgery and particularly the development of Robotically Assisted Dental Implant Surgery to improve the precision and predictability of the procedures while reducing the risk and morbidity of these complex cases.

He believes in the promotion of safely administered outpatient anesthesia and conscious sedation for oral surgical procedures, and providing the indigent patient population of Central Florida access to dental care.

He is active in Organized Dentistry. He has served as president of the Dental Society of Greater Orlando, the Florida Society of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, and the Florida Dental Society of Anesthesiology.

In 2002, he was inducted into the American College of Dentists, an honor bestowed to less than 3% of the dentists in the United States. Since its inception in 2003, he has been recognized by his peers as one of the "Best Dentists in America" as published by Woodward/White, Inc. in Orlando Magazine and continues to hold that distinction. Since 2009, he has been consistently awarded the "Best Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon in Winter Park" by the Winter Park Chamber of Commerce.
